**Your Nokia E62 with BlackBerry Connect™ allows you to send and receive email from multiple supported email accounts. Set-up is simple. You can do it online at your computer, or right from your phone.**

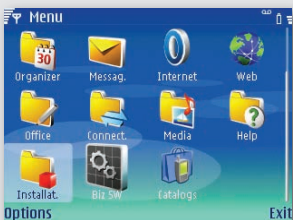
You can configure each business and/or personal email account individually, and with multiple 'Sent From' email addresses, you can always choose the one you want to reply or compose from. There are no email storage quotas to deal with.<sup>1</sup> And you don't have to manage the same message in two places: your desktop account is updated whenever you send, delete or read a message on your Nokia E62.<sup>2</sup>

Could you use an extra email account? You can create one with a new BlackBerry® email address. And because this account is completely wireless, you never need to use a desktop computer to manage it.

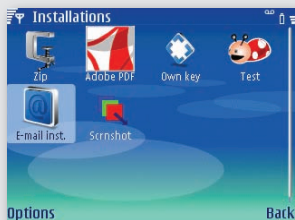
# Installing BlackBerry Connect

## To install the BlackBerry Connect application to your Nokia E62:

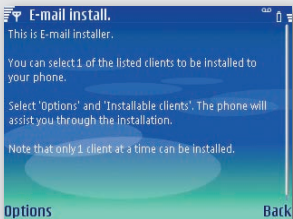
First, make sure that your SIM card is inserted and that you've activated an appropriate BlackBerry data plan for your Nokia E62. Next:



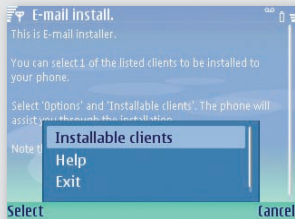
1. Press the **Menu** button (to the left of the joystick). Scroll down and select **Installations**.



2. Select **Email Installer**.



3. Select **Options**.



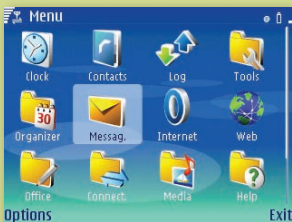
4. Select **Installable clients**.



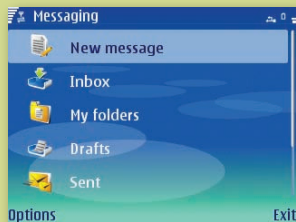
## Option A

### To create your BlackBerry Internet Service account directly from your Nokia E62:

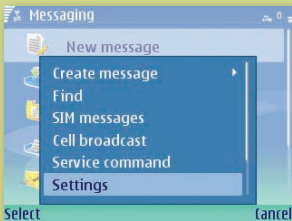
First, make sure BlackBerry Connect is installed on your phone and that you're in an area of wireless coverage. Next:



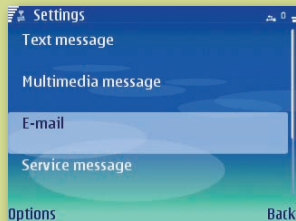
1. Press the **Menu** button (to the left of the joystick). Select **Message.**



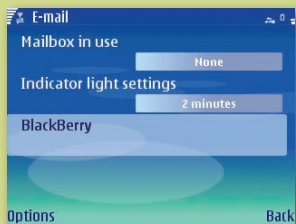
2. Select **Options.**



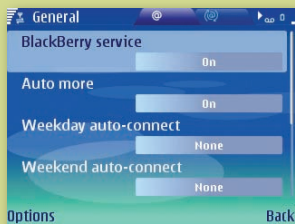
3. Select **Settings.**



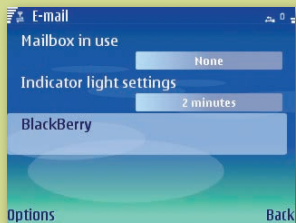
4. Select **E-mail.**



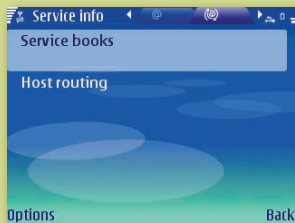
5. Select **BlackBerry**.



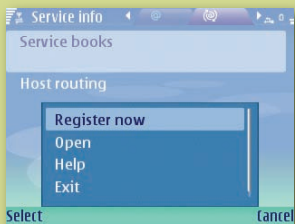
6. Change the option for **BlackBerry service** to **On** by pressing the joystick.



7. Select **Back** to return to the previous screen. This will activate the BlackBerry Connect application. Re-select **BlackBerry**.

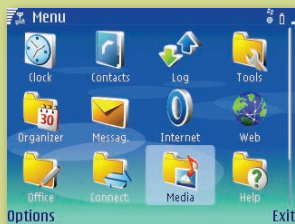


8. Scroll over once to the **Service info** screen. Select **Options**.



9. Select **Register Now**.

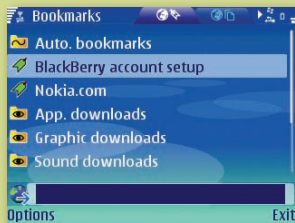
Once your phone is fully connected, the **BlackBerry Connect** icon  appears on the home screen.



10. Press the **Menu** button (to the left of the joystick). Select **Media**.

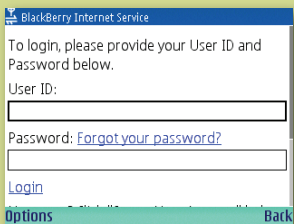


11. Select **Services**.

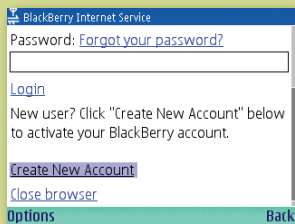


12. Select the **BlackBerry account setup** bookmark. The phone's browser opens ...

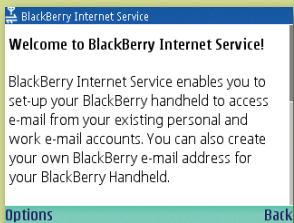




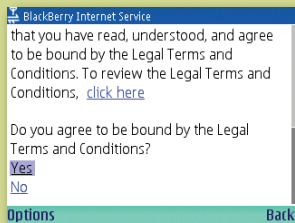
... and displays the BlackBerry Internet Service sign-in page.



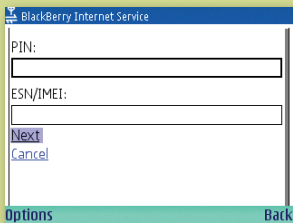
13. Scroll down and select **Create New Account.**



14. Read the **Terms and Conditions.**

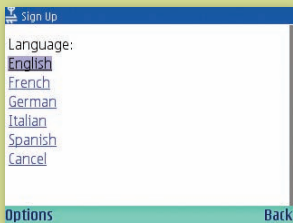


15. Scroll down and select **Yes** to agree to the Terms and Conditions.

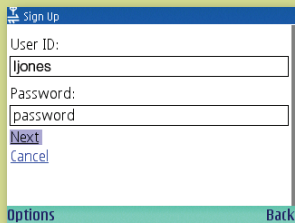


16. Enter the **PIN** and **ESN/IMEI**.  
Select **Next**.

NOTE: To find the PIN and IMEI, select Menu > Messaging > Options > Settings > E-mail > BlackBerry > Scroll over twice to the Device Info screen.



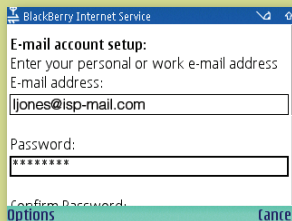
18. Select a **language** for the BlackBerry Internet Service website.



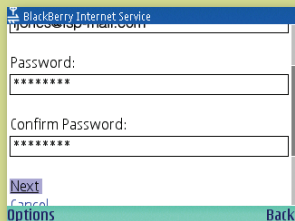
17. Decide on and enter a **User ID** and **Password** for your BlackBerry Internet Service account.  
Select **Next**.

The final step in the set-up process is to integrate an existing supported email account or to create a BlackBerry email address directly from your Nokia E62.

## Integrating an existing email account directly from your Nokia E62



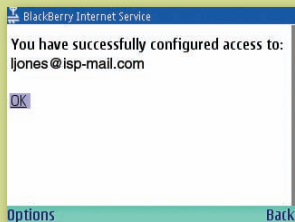
1. Fill in the required information, including **E-mail address**, **Password** and **Confirm Password**.



2. Scroll down and select **Next**.

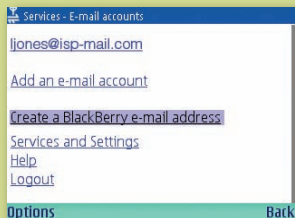
Depending on your account type, you may be prompted for additional information, which may include **Email Server**, **User Name**, **Web Access URL**, **Account Name** and **Use SSL**. If so, enter the information, then scroll down and select **Next**.

If the account was successfully configured, you'll receive a confirmation message on your Nokia E62.



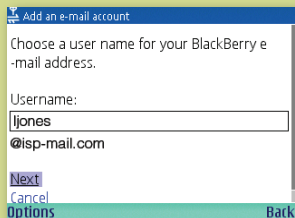
3. Select **OK**.

## Creating a new BlackBerry email address directly from your Nokia E62

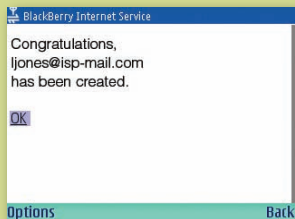


1. Select **Create a BlackBerry e-mail address**.

If the user name you've entered is available, you'll receive a message on your Nokia E62 letting you know the account was successfully created.



2. Enter a user name (which will also be the name portion of your BlackBerry email address) and select **Next**.



3. Select **OK**.

## Option B

### To create your BlackBerry Internet Service account directly from your computer:

First, make sure that your computer is connected to the Internet and that your web browser is pointed to [www.rogers.com/bis](http://www.rogers.com/bis). Next:



1. Click **Create New Account**.

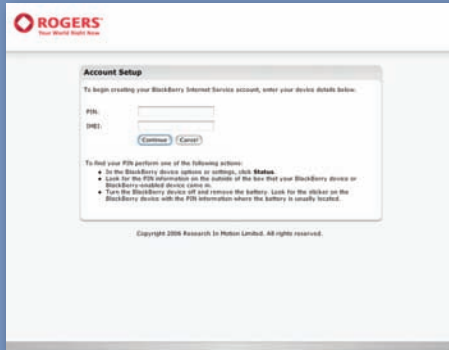


2. Read and agree to the **Terms and Conditions**.

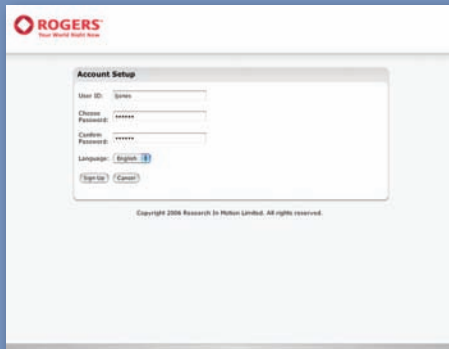


3. Type the **PIN** and **IMEI**.

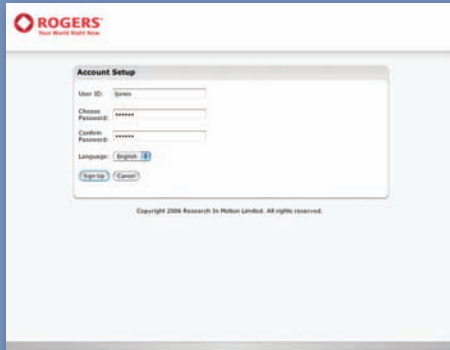

4. Click **Continue**.



5. Decide on and enter a **User ID** and **Password** for your BlackBerry Internet Service account. Confirm your password and select a **language** for the BlackBerry Internet Service website.



6. Click **Sign Up**.



7. Now you're ready to follow the previous instructions for **Integrating an existing email account** and **Creating a new BlackBerry email address**.
